WAIMEA WATERFALL & CIRCLE ISLAND ADVENTURE



Driving through the colorful art and surfing town of Haleiwa you will arrive at the lush and beautiful Waimea Valley. This enchanting location, also known as the "Valley of the Priests" and consisting of 1,875 scenic acres, has been a sacred place for more than 700 years of native Hawaiian history. World famous botanical gardens containing over 5000 species of tropical and subtropical flowering plants, ancient archaeological sites, and one of Oahu's most scenic waterfalls await you. After stopping at the world-renowned surfing location of Banzai Pipeline we arrive at one of the North Shore's most famous shrimp stands where you







will be served your choice of nine different sautéed shrimp plates with steaming rice while learning about Hawaii's aquacultural efforts. Traveling along the scenic and relaxing windward coast of Oabu we arrive at the exotic Macadamia Nut Farm where you can sample a delicious assortment of tropical grown treats. NATURAL HIGHLIGHTS OF OAHU ADVENTURE



Join Oahu's most experienced eco-tour company visiting many beautiful locations in a style and with information that no other company can provide. We visit the world famous Hanauma Bay (closed Tuesdays), along the island's stunning southeast volcanic coastline. Our next stop is *Halona Cove*, where Green Sea Turtles and Humpback Whales (seasonal) swim in the crystal clear waters off "From Here to Eternity Beach" and a blowhole shoots columns of saltwater into the sky. After stopping at Makapu'u Lookout, and enjoying breathtaking panoramic views of offshore islands, we visit colorful tide pools and the 25,000 year old Kaupo lava flow. Your professional guide will show you rare species of native Hawaiian coastal plants and a variety of colorful seabirds including Red-footed Boobies, Great Frigatebirds and Red-tailed Tropicbirds. Just past "Robin's Nest", where Magnum P.I. was filmed, we stop for a walk on Oahu's longest sandy beach and enjoy the aquamarine waters of Waimanalo Bay where tropical fish and corals abound. Our next stop, Enchanted Lake **Bird Sanctuary**, is one of the premier birdwatching locations on Oahu where several species of rare Hawaiian birds can be observed. We travel to the *ancient* Hawaiian Temple, Ulupou Heiau, to see one of Oahu's best preserved archaeological sites and to learn about many important Polynesian plants. At the world renowned Pali Lookout, described by Mark Twain as one of the most beautiful views on Earth, you will see the turquoise waters of Kane'obe Bay and the jagged, 2,000 foot vertical cliffs of the majestic Koʻolau volcano.

NORTH SHORE AND CIRCLE ISLAND TOUR







Travel with the island's premier eco-tour company on an exciting journey of discovery to the famous North Shore of Oahu. Driving over the Ko'olau **Mountains** to the windward side, our first stop is the fabled **Valley of the Temples** where we visit the picturesque **Byodo Temple** located at the base of stunning 2,000 foot lush green cliffs. Then we drive along the scenic shores of **Kahana Bay** arriving at **Laie Point**, a great opportunity to observe several native plant species while marveling at the breathtaking views of Kukuihoolua *islet* and the wild and rugged *eastern-Oabu coastline*. Continuing North to Kabuku, we visit a shrimp farm to see endangered water birds, including Black-neck stilts, Hawaiian coots and Moorbens. Our next stop is the world famous **Sunset Beach** where incredible waves thrill viewers, especially between November and April. Following the stunning coastline of legendary Waimea Bay we stop at a well-known basking and feeding ground to look for wild Green Sea Turtles. Traveling South we drive through the colorful and bistoric village of Haleiwa, home to many surfers, artists and craftspeople. After passing extensive pineapple fields we arrive at our last stop, the bistoric Dole Plantation.
